

**2020/ 2021 fare table via Rosslare-Fishguard –  
Adult single (one-way) standard fares**

***In November, 2020 Sailrail fares ex Éire increased for the first time since 2015. Only a standard fare is available (there is no longer an advance fare).***

***Single fares for Zones A, B & C have increased by €13  
Single fares for Zones D & E have increased by €14***

Passengers follow the open air pedestrian route between these locations; this takes approximately eight minutes to walk and there is a footpath throughout.
