**Notes:**

- Return fare = double the single fare.
- Fare for children (5 to 15 years inclusive) = half adult fare. Infants (0 to 4 years inclusive): free.
- Fares are all-in station to station fares including the ferry.
- No luggage charges or hidden extras.
- There is no shuttle bus available for transfer between the station and terminal at Rosslare Europort. Passengers follow the open air pedestrian route between these locations; this takes approximately eight minutes to walk and there is a footpath throughout. - **SailRail can be booked through to National Rail and Overground stations in the London area (e.g. Acton Central, Hampstead Heath, Kew Gardens, Kilburn High Road, Stratford & Wembley Central) but SailRail is not valid on Tube (Underground services).**
- *It appears that a November, 2020 planned Sailrail fares increase ex Éire didn't materialise (the fares quoted have remained the same since 2015). Only a standard fare is available (there is no longer an advance fare).*
